RULES & REGULATIONS

LEAGUE AUTHORITY

1. The operation of this league is under the direction of THE COURTS EZONE Athletic Director and Supervisors whom will be responsible for scheduling league games, providing and assigning courts, officials, protests, crowd control, and league organization.
2. Registration is on a first come, first serve basis. The Athletic Director reserves the right to place teams in any division.
3. There shall be no refund of individual or team entry fee for any reason. If a team check is returned for insufficient funds, that team will forfeit all previous games and be expelled from the league unless payment in the form of cash, cashier's check, or money order is received before the next game.
4. **THE COURTS EZONE LLC will not be responsible for any injuries or accidents incurred by players or spectators. ALL PLAYERS MUST SIGN THE REQUIRED WAIVER FORM. By signing the waiver, the team and its players agree to abide by all regulations and further agree to hold harmless THE COURTS EZONE LLC, its staff, officials, owners of the facility, all other participants, coaches, and sponsors from any injury sustained due to participation. ___ initial**
5. **The written schedule is the official document of the league and cannot be altered. Games shall not be rescheduled for a different day, time, or court unless games are cancelled due to adverse weather, unplayable facilities, emergency's, or error on The Courts behalf. If there is a question regarding adverse or inclement weather affecting scheduled game times, coaches are to call 831-3333 ext. 4 and listen to the message. ___ initial**
6. Teams must furnish their own uniforms, which shall consist of shirts that are like in color, with a number on the back and/or front.

TEAM ROSTER & WAIVER

1. **The team roster is due prior to the first game and payment is due on or before the designated first game. ___ initial**
2. The LIABILITY WAIVER with all players and legal guardians, for participants under legal age, signatures must be received PRIOR to the first game.
3. If a player is added to a team after the roster and waiver has been turned in, the individual must be added to the roster and sign the liability waiver before the start of the game.
4. A player not on the roster and who has not signed the liability waiver is considered ineligible. If an ineligible player is used in a game, it will result in a forfeit for that team.
5. **Players competing on an "A" Division team are eligible to participate with a "B" Division team in the same grade/age level. Players are not permitted to participate in more than one team per league/**

division. Players can play up in higher grade/age leagues but cannot play below their current grade/age level. ___ initial

PLAYER AND TEAM CONDUCT

1. THE COURTS EZONE reserves the authority to forfeit any game in which an infraction occurs and has the right to remove any player from competition for up to the entire season for abusive language and/or unsportsmanlike conduct of any variety. Any player or coach being assessed two technical fouls in one game will be removed from that game and suspended the following game.
2. Any personnel employed by THE COURTS EZONE to officiate or supervise games have the authority to evict player(s) from the game or bench.
3. Any team involved in more than two incidents in which one of their players is evicted from the game will forfeit all previous games and loses the privileges of further participation in the league without refund.
4. No alcoholic beverages are allowed on the premises by anyone and such an infraction will result in suspension of individuals or the entire team.
5. Only non-marking athletic shoes will be allowed to be worn on the playing floor. No one other than players and up to two coaches will be permitted on or around the benches at any time. Coaches are not permitted on the playing area at any time during the game unless a player injury occurs.
6. **Both warm-up and game balls will be provided. Coaches will be issued balls prior to each game and will be responsible for accounting for all balls at the completion on each game. Please do not bring in, or allow players to bring in basketballs for individual use. ___ initial**
7. **Food and drink (including bottled water) not purchased at THE COURTS complex will not be allowed into the facility. No gum chewing will be permitted in the building. ___ initial**
8. There will be a \$2.00 admission fee for all non-participants 16 and over attending a game.
9. Protests must be received in writing by 5:00pm the day following the game and are to be submitted to the Athletic Director along with a \$25 protest fee. A decision will be made prior to the next game and, if upheld, the protest fee will be returned. There will be no protest of judgement calls.
