



“MAKE-UP” DAY POLICY

Over the last year, The Courts has continued to work on improving their policies in changing games after the schedule has been released. We at The Courts realize that unforeseeable circumstance do arise that will force a team to be unable to attend a game.

The Courts will be implementing a new “Make-Up” day policy effective at the beginning of its Early Fall Session on August 31st, 2010 in an attempt to limit the number of game changes after the initial schedule has been released.

- **If a team is unable to field a team for their game and The Courts is notified at least 24 hours, The Courts will attempt to move that game to a designated “make-up” day later in the session.** The designated day will be set at the beginning of the league. If one or either of the teams are unable to participate in that game, the team that cancelled the original date will be given a forfeit and the opposing team will be scheduled another game.
- **If a conflict occurs less than 24 hours prior to the game, it is the responsibility of the team representative to contact a Courts representative.** If there is a reasonable way to reschedule the game on that session’s designated “make-up” day, it will be considered. If not, the game will be considered a forfeit.

Please respect the fact that the more cancellations each team asks for to accommodate their own schedule, the more hardships it causes for the other teams involved. Please limit your cancellations to only those that are truly essential and those that limit your team to less than five players.
